

The Department of Environmental Studies at New York University is searching for **3 Recitation Leaders** for Environment and Society, taught by [Professor Anne Rademacher](#).

Course Description:

Environment and Society examines several of the major concepts that have been developed and refined over the years, decades and centuries to attempt to understand humanity's relationship with nature and manage our impact on the environment. Many of the ideas will explore a range of environmental sub-disciplines, from environmental governance and ethics, to environmental justice and history. More specifically, the issues covered will include environmental history and concepts of nature and the environment; the rise of environmentalism; environmental skepticism; anthropogenic global change; population and consumption, ecological footprint analysis and other environmental indicators; environmental justice; public goods and collective action problems; environmental politics; environmental values; and the future of environmentalism. It will cover a very significant amount of demanding material, in order to prepare students for upper-level courses. This course will be challenging, and students should expect a steep learning curve. Recitation Leaders will be available to help students along the way.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Ph.D. degree, Masters degree, or a current Masters or Ph.D. student in environmental social sciences or humanities
- Coursework and/or experience in environmental social sciences or humanities

- Attend all lectures (Monday, Wednesday; 11am-12:15pm)
- Lead 2 recitation sections once per week (approximately 20 students per section), recitation assignment to be determined by the program
